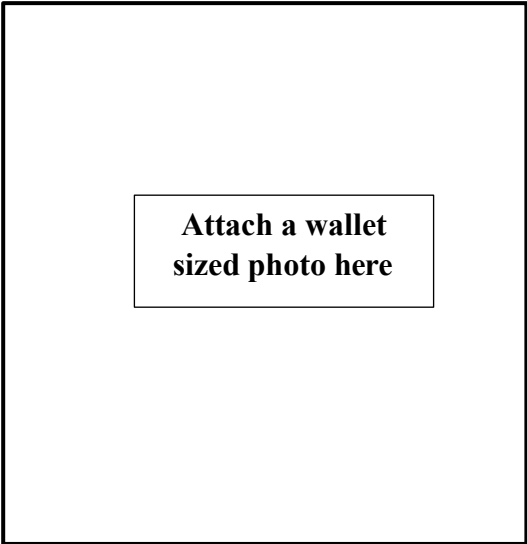

Junior Fair Royalty Contest Rules

Jr. Fair Royalty Applications are due to the OSU Extension office by **Monday, August 5th**, Interviews will be on **Tuesday, August 13th**, and Crowning will be on **Tuesday, September 3rd at 4:30 pm** at the small stage

1. Jr. Fair Royalty members will not be permitted to wear shorts, cut-off shirts, t-shirts, or faded jeans under any circumstances.
2. Jr. Fair Royalty members are required to wear dresses, dress slacks, or new dress jeans with dress blouses, dress or sport shirts, sweaters, etc. No flip-flops or open-toed shoes are permitted in the show arena and royalty may wear shoes appropriate to the weather conditions. If you have a livestock exhibit at the fair, you may wear your desired show apparel during the show only. Royalty will not be permitted to wear sash and/or crown while showing livestock but are expected to wear them at all other times during the fair.
3. Jr. Fair Royalty members are expected to be at their assigned shows on time. Shows and times will be given to each member on Tuesday of the fair when royalty members must meet with Jr. Fair Board royalty committee.
4. Jr. Fair Royalty members are to present ribbons and trophies at all junior fair shows.
5. If for some reason, there is a conflict in your attendance of a show, you must contact Jr. Fair Board advisor (FFA Instructor or Sophia Whisman).
6. All current (2024) and previous year's royalty will participate in the Closing Day Parade on Saturday, September 7th beginning at 9:30am.
7. The queen is encouraged to represent Morgan County in the Ohio Fair Manager's Queens Contest in January, providing she meets the state requirements.
8. The current year's court will crown the new court at the county fair the following year.
9. Jr. Fair Royalty members should try to represent Morgan County at as many public functions after the fair as possible. (e.g. July 4th parade, other county fair parades when invited)
10. The King, Queen, Prince, Princess, Jr. Prince, or Jr. Princess can win only one year. The only exception to this rule is if an interested party applies by the deadline indicating they would like to be considered for a second year **if no other individuals apply**. Each Jr. Prince, Jr. Princess, Prince and Princess can be eligible for Prince, Princess, King or Queen, respectively, when they are within the age limits.
