The following policy is stated in the State Uniform Rules for 4-H Horse Shows and will be in effect for the Morgan County Fair, Morgan County PAS Show (State Fair qualifier), Ohio State Fair and all Ohio 4-H equine events. All youth age 19 and under, participating in any 4-H equestrian activity, are required to wear properly fitted protective headgear which meets or exceeds current ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards with the chin harness securely fastened at all times while riding or driving an equine.
