Skillathon - Exhibitors must participate in appropriate Skillathon to exhibit livestock at the County Fair.

Showmanship: (1) All contestants must show an animal that is their 4-H or FFA project for the current year and must be shown in the current year's junior fair show, (2) Judging is based on cleanliness and grooming of animal and showman, member's ability to show the animal and member's behavior in the ring. **Showmanship MUST BE MARKED ON THIS FORM if you want to compete in the Showmanship contest. YOU CANNOT COMPETE IN SHOWMANSHIP AT THE FAIR WITHOUT ENTERING NOW.**

SHOWMANSHIP (Your responsibility to mark appropriate area – first by age, then by level)

- 1. ____ Senior Showmanship -- 14-18 as of January 1; plus junior showmanship winners of previous years
- 2. ____ Junior Showmanship -- 9-13 as of January 1, and shown previously
- 3. ____ Beginners Showmanship -- 1ST YR. EXHIBITORS, 11 & younger as of January 1
- 4. ____ Showman of Showmen – For previous showman of showmen and senior showmanship winners ONLY
